

## **Strengthening Our Leaders (SOL)**

The Strengthening Our Leaders (SOL) program is a local program that provides educational enriching opportunities for youth ages 6-14 with existing SOL (Standards of Learning) programs. This includes tutorial support and assistance for SOL preparation, test-taking skills, math, science, reading, language arts, and computer skills.

SOL has two branches that serve the Northern Virginia area: Arlington and Alexandria.

### **SOL Arlington**

SOL Arlington is partnering with the Nauck Community Services Center to offer tutoring to children in the Nauck Community of Arlington. All students are pretested to identify their current levels and needs. Volunteers who specialize in Elementary, Middle and High School concentrations assist the students with homework and grade specific activities. The program meets twice a week on Tuesday (Math Focus) and Thursday (Reading Focus).
